# TREASURER'S REPORT

Received revenue sharing of approximately \$35,000 and \$1500 from landfill for recycling. Account balances: General Fund - \$251,634.70; Cemetery - \$25,913.86; Parks - \$45,058.38; Road Fund - \$255,074.40; Luzerne Fire Fund - \$1,418.95; Fire Millage - \$202,281.51.

#### FIRE RPORT

Firefighters responded to a grass fire and down power line, and completed trainings on search & rescue in confined spaces. Completed pump test on all pumpers, and did maintenance on pumper. Water rescue training on 9/24. Firemen's Memorial this weekend, Fire Chief Roddy requesting funds (\$250) to spend at Firemen's Memorial.

County contributing up to \$9000 for radio tower, have applied to USFS for more funding.

# SUPERVISOR'S REPORT

Responded to junk complaints, attempting to serve Boyer (Lansing area) on their complaint. Cole property is in the process of being cleaned up; T. Holberton's house has been cleaned up; sent 2 letters to property owner on Nash (complaint received at meeting last month). Two properties where owner is deceased so there's no one to sue to get it cleaned up.

# **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Tri-Town had a meeting, major issues with trucks. One of the pumpers is leaking and passed the pump test, and the other pumper did not pass. One of the trucks has a cracked frame and must be replaced. Received a Par Plan grant for upgraded entry and security system.

Utility Authority – good financial shape, getting enough income to make debt payments; need to do some upgrades on the driveway before winter.

Ordinance committee – no activity since November.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

**Copy Machine** – Have a Xerox to try out, total \$8119.10. Have \$5000 in Township Board, and \$4000 in Elections equipment. This machine provides what we require in printing.

Mitchell/Avery to purchase Xerox Workcentre 7830i multifunction copier. All ayes. Motion carried.

Dangerous buildings ordinance

- Park rental refunds Poor maintenance, water not available on one date.

McGregor/Mitchell – to refund Comstock Park rental fees to Kann and William Cardinal due to poor maintenance and unavailable utilities. All ayes. Motion carried.

- Trees in streetscape McGregor will check with a couple landscape places in Traverse City, and talk to Wyckoff re: Mentor replacing theirs.
- Millage Levy –

Booth/McGregor to levy the maximum allowed by law for both General Fund & Fire Millage. All ayes. Motion carried.

• Peninsula Fiber Request to lay fiber along 12<sup>th</sup> St.

McGregor/Mitchell – to approve request from Peninsula Fiber to lay fiber along 12th St. All ayes.
